Inside a Church


Cross

An ambo is used for the vicar to read from.







THE HUMAN EYE

The eye is a ball with a hole at the front, the pupil, which lets in light inside the eye. A lens which focuses the light onto a screen at the back of the eyeball. This surface is called the retina and is made up of special cells which detect light and send messages to our brain, allowing us to see.

When we move our eyes, better, an optic nerve shines a light into our eye and sends a message to the brain. This shows the optic nerve, blood vessels on the surface of the retina and the light-sensitive cells. A human eye has more than 100,000,000 light-sensitive cells. The skin on top of your eyes is called eyelids. Your eyelids open and close quickly in order to keep your eyes moistened. This is called blinking.

Why We Celebrate Diwali...
