

Year 4 learning log menu of activities – Autumn Term 2020

This term, we are giving you a range of activities to choose from! Our expectation is that you **choose a task each week** and **upload it by the end of the week**. If you want to, you can even choose to do **more** than one each week! **Each piece you choose to complete will be worth a maximum of 3 dojo points.**

Choose one of our school values (empathy, curiosity, perseverance, inclusive, responsibility, courage, aspiration) and produce a piece of work that explains/shows what it means.

Choose a festival which is celebrated in Autumn or Winter, e.g Diwali, Halloween, Christmas. Present your information in a creative and interesting way.

Prepare a magic trick. Perform your magic trick to an audience e.g. someone in your family or your class.

Explain the Human Digestive system - what happens to your food once you have swallowed it?

Interview an older member of your family (eg parents/grandparents) about what school was like for them when they were a child.

Create your own food chain or food web.

Make a maths game to help you practise your times tables. Remember it needs to go up to 12 x 12.

Imagine you are a book critic and write a review about a book you have recently read. Who were the main characters? What happened? What was your favourite part and why?

Collect some words! You could collect them from your reading book, the internet or words that you hear in conversation. Choose up to five interesting words or phrases and explain what they mean.

Describe an imaginary place – use expanded noun phrases and prepositions to create a picture of your setting in your readers mind.

Remember to read every day at home – get your diary signed; practise your times tables and spellings; and complete your Century homework.
