

Year 6 learning log menu of activities – Autumn Term 2020

This half term, we are giving you a range of activities to choose from! Our expectation is that you **choose a task each week** and **give it in by each Wednesday**. If you want to, you can even choose to do **more** than one each week! **Each piece you choose to complete will be worth a maximum of 3 Dojo points.**

1) Find out more about the history of Leicester/your local area. You can choose any format to present your work (you could even make a model of one of Leicester's landmarks).

2) Create a piece of work about the human eye - you could make a model, draw a labelled diagram or research about how that different parts of your eye work.

3) Write/create a biography about a scientist who studied light - what can you find out about them and their life? See if you can present your biography in an interesting way.

4) Make a travel brochure about Leicester. You can choose whether you include information about modern Leicester or even Leicester's past.

5) Find out about a charity – it could be a local one or a national/international charity. What do they do? How do they try to help? Think creatively about how you could show what you have found out.

6) Create a diary entry - it could be a blog post, presentation, written, recorded or even use pictures to represent what happened in your day.

7) Write some top tips on how to be an effective participator in and out of school.

8) Design a mad invention - the crazier the better! You could make a model, an advert or even design a blue-print showing the different parts of your creation.

9) Find out about one of the festivals that is celebrated during Autumn. You could research Harvest, Diwali, Navratri or Halloween. Present your research in an interesting way.

10) Write a play script of a scene from a book you have read. You could perform it for your friends /family and ask them to write about it in your learning log.
