

Merrydale Sport Provision 2016-17

Sports Partnerships

This year we continued our affiliation with a number of different sports programmes. We purchased a package from the Leicester City School Sport & Physical Activity Network (SSPAN) which is the main source of our competitive sports provision. In addition to this, we attended a number of DSAT organised sports competitions to take our overall participation in out of schools events to over 25. A boys' and girls' team participated in the Leicester City FC Primary School League throughout the school year, with success for both teams. We also took part in a local football knock-out tournament organised by a nearby school.

Sport Events

We have again attended many events during the school year which has enabled the children to continue to participate in a range of different activities in a competitive and non-competitive environment. Our involvement in inter-school competitions has remained around the same level as last year. We did not continue our sport package with Crown Hills for this year as we anticipated that we would attend many DSAT organised events and therefore money could be spent elsewhere on resources to improve the extra-curricular provision. Consequently, this has resulted in participation figures remaining around the same level as we did not attend the sport festivals held by Crown Hills, which offer over 30 places to each school participating.

Achievements

Our children have again shown many skills throughout the year in various sports. We have offered a very broad P.E curriculum that has allowed the children to learn many skills and become more knowledgeable about the sports that they are participating in. Our children have achieved a lot of great positions with our teams finishing high in sports like tri-golf, cross-country, TAG-Rugby and hockey.

The boys' cricket team and girls' football team won their respective competitions for the second consecutive year. As a result of winning the East Leicester Cricket Competition the team qualified for the summer championships where they proved to be one of the strongest teams in the county. The boys' football team also won their group at Judgemeanow in the autumn term.

Our school has achieved the Gold school games mark for the second consecutive year. This mark reflects on the schools physical education and sport provision and takes into account participation figures in extra-curricular activities, the P.E curriculum that we offer and how engaged the children are in physical education and sport. The aim for the school is to achieve another gold mark for next year by continuing to improve what is already in place.

This year we ran a running programme for the children at lunch times. This has proved a big success with 100% of the school participating across the year. This has definitely had an impact on the children's fitness and running ability with many top 15 finishes at cross country events as well as winning medals in the 400m at Saffron Lane.
