Merrydale Sport Provision 2017-18

Sports Partnerships

This year we continued our affiliation with a number of different sports programmes. We continued our package with the Leicester City School Sport & Physical Activity Network (SSPAN) which is the main source of our competitive sports provision. In addition to this, we attended various DSAT organised sports competitions to take our overall participation in out of schools events to over 25. A boys' and girls' team participated in the Leicester City FC Primary School League throughout the school year, with success for the boys' team who reached the finals held at King Power Stadium. We also took part in the Celsian Cup - a local football knock-out tournament where we reached the latter stages.

Sport Events

We have again attended many events during the school year which has enabled the children to continue to participate in a range of different activities in a competitive and non-competitive environment. Our involvement in inter-school competitions has remained at the same level as the previous year however we did take more children to events this year which is improved our overall participation numbers.

Achievements

Our children have again shown many skills throughout the year in various sports. We have offered a very broad P.E curriculum that has allowed the children to learn many skills and become more knowledgeable about the sports that they are participating in. Our year 3 & 4 gymnastics team managed to win the East Leicester competition and then went onto compete in the county finals. We also finished runners up in many competitions including cricket, gymnastics (years 5 & 6), mini tennis, tri-golf and Tag rugby.

Our school has achieved the gold school games mark for the third consecutive year. This mark reflects on the schools physical education and sport provision and takes into account participation figures in extra-curricular activities, the P.E curriculum that we offer and how engaged the children are in physical education and competitive sport.

We achieved a high position in the end of year participation summary for the school year where we came 2nd in East Leicester for our competition involvement and 4th place overall for the whole of Leicester City.

At lunch time we continued to have a running programme for the children alongside playground activities led by our sports leaders. This has ensured that 100% of the children in the school were engaged in extra-curricular activities during the 2017-18 school year. Our sports leaders attended a leadership course through the Leicester City SSPAN where they learnt some valuable skills in leading activities. This proved very beneficial to the rest of the school as they were able to provide many different activities at lunch time for children to get involved in. Our sports leaders also helped to run our 'golden ticket' initiative where we identified the least active children in year 3 and gave them a pass to attend lunch time activities. This proved very successful at motivating children to participate in a structured lunch time activity. Our year 5 leaders from 2017-18 (now year 6) will carry on their roles into the 2018-19 school year and we will select children from the new year 5 group to attend the leadership course to ensure that our sports leaders will be in place for years to come.
